Fall Cleanup

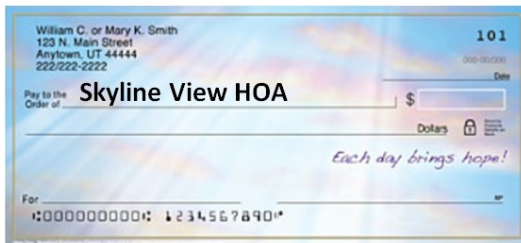
As fall is coming to an end and most of the leaves have fallen from the trees, we spend a lot of time cleaning up the those pesky leaves from our yards.

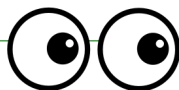


Landscape Changes to Pool Area:
