OUR OWN KIDDIE PARK

ENJOY THE SVA Kiddie Park at the end of Overlook Court. Please observe posted signs. Swings, slides, and other equipment is for children 12 years and younger. Rules and Regulations state that you are responsible for hauling your trash and dog poop back to your home for disposal.

WATCH YOUR SPEED

Please keep your speed to **25 miles per hour** or under when driving through the neighborhood. There are quite a few young children within the Association.

Children and adult walkers and bike riders cross Skyline View Drive at the Ditch Trail. Please slow down to **15 MPH** in this area.



Help Save WATER

We know that we have had a very wet winter but we would still like to save water. Please, when watering your grass and plant make sure you are conserving water as much as possible. Also, if you see excessive water run off, broken sprinklers, or water running in the common areas when it should not be please call or email management so they can work on fixing the problem. Thank you!

Be a Good Pet Owner

We are seeing more and more dog waste left in the neighborhood. Please clean up after your pet.

Rules & Regulation require that all dogs must be on leash and under control. A continuously barking dog (at any time of day or night) is a violation of City and County regulations.



Parking on the Side Streets

Curbs on one side of each street in your Association are for fire engine emergency access. Do not park in red zones. Your vehicle may be towed by the Fire Department.

Tennis Courts and Pool

Use of Association common areas and facilities are for all owners/residents, and their guests. Each owner/resident has been issued a key-fob to permit access tennis courts and pool area. Do not loan your key-fob to others. Do not open gates for others. Entry into Association facilities by other means (climbing over a fence, for example) is considered trespassing. For security and safety, do not prop or block open any gates. Washoe County Health Dept. may revoke our pool permit for safety infractions. You must cleanup and remove your trash from Association facilities. Consult your Rules & Regulation document for more details.

Tables, chairs, lounges:

Use of tables, chairs and lounges, is first-come, first-served, and may not be reserved. Do not move these items into the tennis court area, as these damage the court surface. Please cleanup and remove trash.

Swimming Pool Rules

1. The hours of the pool are from 7 am to 10 pm. Use at any other time will not be permitted and police will be called.
2. There is no lifeguard on duty. Anyone using the pool does so at his/her own risk and holds the Association and the Board of Directors harmless. The Washoe County District Health Department requires bathing with at least one other person (no solo swimming).
3. All persons under the age of fourteen (14) must be accompanied by an adult who assumes responsibility and liability for their care and supervision. This is in accordance with the Washoe County District Health Department Regulations.
4. Appropriate bathing attire must be worn at all times. Cutoffs are not allowed, as loose strings and thread will clog the filters.
5. No glassware, bottles, nor glass of any kind is allowed in the area for the safety of pool users. All pool users are required to remove their own litter. Trash containers are provided.
6. No pets are allowed in the pool area.
7. Stereos must be listened to using personal headphones so as not to disturb others. Excessive shouting, rowdy behavior and dangerous horseplay shall not be allowed.
8. No running, jumping, or loud behavior is permitted.
9. No floatation devices or air mattresses larger than 3'x6' are allowed at any time.
10. No persons with open or infected sores, cuts, or abrasions shall be allowed in the pool.
11. Parents will be notified immediately if their minors engage in damaging or dangerous activities in the pool area at any time. Parents are financially responsible for damages done by their minors. Parents are also fully responsible for the personal safety of their minors.
12. The Board may employ a pool monitor to assist in the operating of the pool, and to enforce these rules and regulations. We ask your cooperation with his/her directions.

NOTICE

Children must wear waterproof swim diapers if not yet trained to go to the bathroom alone.



Tennis Court Rules

1. All players and spectators shall exercise common courtesy.
2. Tennis courts are open every day from 7 a.m. until sunset.
3. Players will limit their playing time to one (1) hour when other players are waiting.
4. The recreation facility gate shall remain locked except for entering and exiting.
5. No food or drink, other than water, shall be permitted in the tennis courts.
6. All players must wear proper tennis shoes. No dark soled or hard-soled shoes are permitted on the tennis courts.
7. Skate boards, roller skates, roller blades, bicycles, etc., are not permitted in the tennis court area at any time.
8. Persons under fourteen (14) may not use the tennis courts unless accompanied by a responsible adult.
9. No pets of any kind shall be permitted in or about the tennis courts. Please leave your pets at home.
10. Owners and/or Tenants who are not in good standing with the Association will be barred from the use of the recreation facility.
