Your Association does NOT provide street cleaning services.

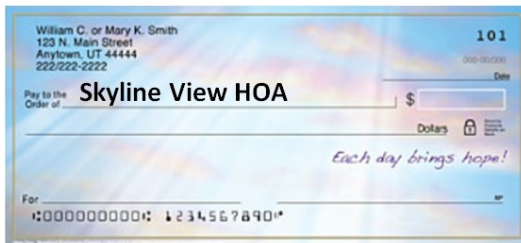


## WATCH YOUR SPEED

### VOLUNTEER

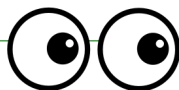
